

REOPENING PROTOCOLS FOR TENNIS FACILITIES

(Post COVID-19 Pandemic)

Most tennis clubs and facilities in Alberta are prepared to meet and exceed current Alberta Health Services Public Health regulations through the Recommended Best Practices as outlined below. Additional actions will be addressed as mandated.

Bring hand sanitizer to disinfect your hands before and after play and avoid touching your face Court times will be limited to a maximum of 120 minutes Each household may reserve a maximum of one time per day Players must supply their own balls to play, and can only handle their supplied tennis balls when serving 	 Singles & doubles with social distancing (maximum 4 players per court) Group instruction will be limited to no more than 4 to 6 players per court + coach Removal of all non-essential equipment (i.e. benches, score cards, umpire chairs) Please come changed (so you do not have to change at the centre) and, arrive and leave as close to the scheduled times as possible to reduce your time at the centre Bring hand sanitizer to disinfect your hands before and after play and avoid touching your face.
