Position Summary:

The role includes teaching children aged 4 - 14 and/or adult lessons including potential evenings and weekends. This is a contract position for the duration of agreed classes. Class dates and times will be agreed upon between the instructor, and the Program and Events Coordinator.

Required Qualifications:

- Coaching or teaching experience in tennis
- Have or be prepared to obtain First Aid/CPR/AED qualifications
- Vulnerable Police Check Essential
- This individual should be outgoing, reliable, and knowledgeable in all aspects of the sport, and 100% committed to providing a fun and competitive playing environment for all our junior and adult players
- Demonstrate good communication skills.
- Be direct in dealing with parents and club members
- Design lessons/activities for the duration of the session that address the skill level of the students
- Must have the ability to be upbeat and energetic throughout each lesson.
- Provide a friendly approach and be knowledgeable about the Junior Tennis Program and help provide a welcoming environment to each student.

Compensation:

Shall be commensurate based on qualifications and past experience. Payment will be made based on the agreed upon number of lessons, and students between the Orchards Residents Association and the instructor.
