Eligibility:

- All coaches applying for Provincial Coach positions must be fully certified under the Tennis Professionals Association (TPA) and the Coach Association of Canada (CAC). Coaches must meet the coaching certification criteria no later than 14 days before the first provincial camp slated for October 1, 2022. Coaches must also demonstrate they have experience developing competitive level junior players at the Fundamentals and Developing stages of the LTAD. Candidates will be assessed on the following eligibility requirements to determine suitability for coaching positions.
- Minimum Coach 2 active certification or working towards as recognized by the Tennis Professionals Association (TPA) and the Coaching Association of Canada (CAC).
- Minimum of 3 years' experience developing athletes through the Fundamentals and Developing stages of the LTAD model.
- Post-secondary education in related field will be considered an asset.
 Demonstrated ability to develop and implement HP programs.
