

Fischer Junior Nationals Selection Process

Alberta Players Compete for Fischer Junior Nationals Spots

Following Provincials Tennis Alberta selects players for Nationals based on National Rankings provided by Tennis Canada.

Rankings are filtered as specified in Tennis Alberta's Junior Competitive Structure.

The top 8 players (4 boys, 4 girls) as listed in Tennis Alberta's Junior Competitive Structure are contacted. Players are asked to complete and return a *Declaration to Compete* and other required waivers.

Players Compete at Fischer Junior Nationals

Players who do not automatically qualify for Nationals are placed on a reserve list, categorized based on National Ranking (per age group and gender).

If an Albertan player declines their spot for a Nationals main draw, the next player on the reserve list -- based on the National Ranking list received from Tennis Canada -- will be contacted.

If other provinces are unable to fill their Nationals spots, Tennis Canada will advise Tennis Alberta of unused spots open for an Albertan player.

Tennis Alberta will contact the concerned player(s) <u>only in the case</u> an unused spot is offered.

Tennis Alberta and Tennis Canada do not award wild cards for Junior National's events.
