<b>TRAVEL CONSENT</b>	<p>Parents are required to complete the Travel Consent Form for <b>ALL</b> players under the age of 21. This must be downloaded, completed and sent to the appropriate provincial coach before the player starts travelling.</p> <p><a href="#">TRAVEL CONSENT</a></p>
<b>FACILITY REGULATIONS</b>	<p>The Granite Club requires all players to wear <b>all white attire</b>. This includes <b>every</b> article of clothing, which must be 90% white, except shoes, which may be coloured.
