SIGN-IN	<p>Alternates only must sign-in for singles qualifying, either in-person or by phone at (905) 758-2027 with the Referee, between 3:00 - 6:00pm July 19, 2025, EST.</p> <p>Players accepted into the Qualifying and Main Draws are not required to sign-in.</p> <p>All players need to be approved by their respective provincial or territorial association to partake in the U18 qualifications.</p>
SINGLES CONSOLATION (OPTIONAL)	<p>Players who have lost their first main draw match and who wish to play consolation, must sign-in in person with the referee within 30 minutes of the conclusion of their main draw match.</p> <p>Ranking points will be awarded based on finishing positions in all main draw events only, not consolation events.</p>
