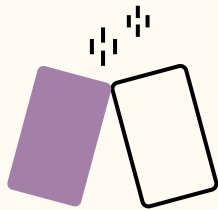

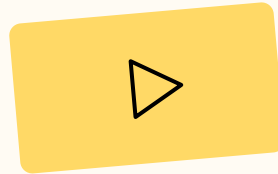

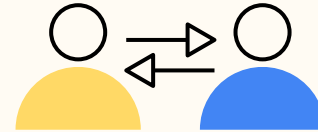

GTC / Tennis Alberta Partnership

In the 2025 off-season, GTC and Tennis Alberta reached an operating partnership for our second year, meaning:

- TA sources the Head Tennis Professional
- TA will lead the Club's junior programming
- The Club has access to the TA platform, Clubspark
- TA will manage membership enrollment with all the same forms of payment
- TA will manage volunteer refunds
- The Club will receive monthly financial reports from TA
- TA and GTC will work together on our website, communications to the membership and growing the club membership levels



Volunteer Activities

Members will be invited to sign up for committees in order to qualify for a membership refund of \$75 (minimum of four hours during the season).

As a coordinator of the committee responsibility will be to request volunteers, organize events and monitor and record volunteer hours. Coordinators will receive a \$100 refund of their membership.



Volunteer Committees

We propose the following committees that members can volunteer for in order to fulfil refund requirements:

We require one person to head and run the committee. (\$100 rebate on membership).

1. Social & Events
2. Court maintenance (screen and net install / take down)
3. Grounds maintenance
